Administration

This continues to be undertaken by trustees and the committee on a voluntary basis, the main areas being Treasurer, Letting secretary and secretary.

We have a new and improved website, herefordallotments.co.uk. The trustees thank Naomi Andersson, an allotment holder, for all her hard work in setting this up and maintaining the site.

Structure and Governance

The HALGS tenancy agreement, rules, terms and conditions have been updated to reflect the charity status and can be found on the website.

Trustees continued to meet regularly through zoom and are always available to respond to members queries.

The day to day running of the sites is managed through site reps who let new plots and discuss with individuals any poorly managed plots. They send reports, via email, on a monthly basis to the Trustees and meet via zoom.

Operational Management

We continue to rely on Herefordshire Council for grass and hedge cutting, which they fund.

We have provided skips on some sites to clear rubbish and stone to fill potholes

We held a COVID safe Summer judging competition and distributed prizes. Unfortunately, we were unable to have a presentation of cups this year

Performance management

There have been some evictions for non-cultivation.

We have established some extra plots, by dividing up larger one that became vacant. There have been new tenancies and there is a waiting list.

Risk management

We maintain membership of the National association of Allotment and Leisure Gardeners, making use of their legal and other advice, also seed ordering from Kings.

Issues and challenges

Dealing with disputes between individual plot holders on sites.

Rental income and small grant from the council at present covers the outgoings. However, costs are projected to increase for water and the sites with buildings on require attention.

Hereford City Council have still not provided us with a lease or details of the amount of grant we will receive.

The standard of grass cutting and hedge cutting provided by the Council is still variable across all sites.

Future Plans

To take on the lease from the council.

To increase the number of sites around the city

Increase tenant awareness of environmentally sustainable growing.

Develop plans for sites to have more water capture and be more sustainable management.

Develop closer links with similar charities to support initiatives that promote overall well-being, improve mental health.

Consider the financial sustainability of HALGS and revise rents as necessary to ensure the organisation can operate

Investigate possible funding opportunities to improve facilities on sites
